North Sound Youth Symphony (NSYS), in cooperation with Western Washington University Department of Music, is based in Bellingham, Washington. NSYS serves musicians ages 9 to 22 in the greater Bellingham/Whatcom County area. NSYS offers two performance levels: *Symphony* for advanced students and *Philharmonia* for intermediate level musicians who wish to have a full orchestral experience.

## NSYS is seeking candidates who have:

- 1. A degree or equivalent experience in orchestral conducting, music education, or music performance
- 2. An enthusiasm for music education and for music-making with young musicians
- 3. Experience conducting youth instrumental music ensembles
- 4. A commitment and demonstrated capacity to working with students of multiple ages, particularly those in middle school and upper elementary grades
- 5. A strong working knowledge of orchestral literature and a willingness to choose repertoire based on the skill level and the composition of the ensemble

## **Responsibilities of the Philharmonia Conductor include:**

- 1. Serving as Philharmonia Conductor for NSYS during rehearsals and performances. The season consists of three sessions of 9–10 two-hour rehearsals on Monday evenings. Each trimester concludes with a concert performance.
- 2. Working with the other Conductor(s) and the Board of Directors of NSYS to establish the yearly calendar of rehearsals and concerts, based on the availability and suitability of facilities.
- 3. Energetically recruiting musicians for the program, including through outreach to local music educators.
- 4. Attending and evaluating acceptance and placement auditions.
- 5. Selecting music for NSYS by working with the other Conductor(s) to choose music for all NSYS concert programs. Arranging for music procurement and rental, as needed.
- 6. Working cooperatively with other NSYS Conductor(s), staff, and music student interns for the benefit of the students in both NSYS ensembles.
- 7. Promoting good public relations and assisting with publicity on behalf of NSYS, as well as performing other such services as may be mutually agreed upon to promote NSYS goals.

Salary: \$6,000-\$7,000 commensurate with experience, and potential for an enrollment bonus
